- We are planning to join with the Town of Brookhaven in moving forward with the next level of IC\$300 which is Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents.

 The NYS Department of Environmental Conservation instituted strict guidelines for the underground storage of petroleum products requiring certified operators. I have obtained the Level A certification and will be assisting the Facilities Director and Assistant Facilities Director in obtaining their Level A certifications as well as obtaining vel B certifications for our Head and Chief Custodians.

- We have completed our annual fire inspection with successful receipt of <u>ABM</u> Certificate of Occupancy's.
- The inspection was completed in one week from July 1th to July 1th.
